Program Information:

This program is a multidisciplinary introduction to China in comparison to the United States. This program will examine the most significant cultural, political, and business environment, such as market transition, in contemporary China. The program visits major Chinese cities such as Beijing, Chengdu and Shanghai. The courses include intense academic study at Peking, Tsinghua and Jiaotong Universities taught by Dr. Yu Henry Xie and Dr. Guoli Liu as well as scholars in local Chinese universities. There will be visits and guided study tours to cultural and historic sites such as the Great Wall and the Forbidden City in Beijing, the Bund in Shanghai, and the unique Panda Research Center in Chengdu.

Participants should be capable of climbing the Great Wall and traveling to mountainous regions of China.

The Program Fee of **\$4,950** includes a non-refundable \$50 application fee, round-trip airfare, lodging, transfers, some meals, medical insurance, entrances into sites, and visa fee for China. **TUITION FOR THE COURSES IS NOT INCLUDED.**

Application deadline is **March 02, 2012**. Deposit of \$550 will be posted to the student's MyCharleston account once the application has been submitted to, and approved by, the CIE. Scholarships of up to \$1500 are available to CoFC students for study abroad. Eligibility is based on demonstrated financial aid and academic merit.
